Saint Selection for your Confirmation Name

Confirmation Candidates are asked to select a saint who inspires you to live a Catholic life. This person should be meaningful to you, someone to whom you have a connection, and someone whose life is a model for yours. You will be confirmed with this name.

Where should you start?

- Look up your own first and middle name
- Think of someone in your family with whom you are close (like your Godparent's names, grandparent's names, or sponsor's name)
- Research "Catholic Saints". Here is one site you can use: http://www.catholic.org/saints/
- Talk to your parents and sponsor for guidance. Facilitator's are a great help as well


Then write!

Prepare an approximate 400 - 500 word essay as to why you selected this saint. Here are some questions you <u>may</u> want to answer as you write your essay:

- Country of origin? Time period of saint's life?
- How you came to learn about this saint?
- Brief description of the saint's early life
- Life experiences of the saint which exemplify a Christian way of life
- Impact of the saint's life on YOU & the Catholic community

And you should answer this question:

• Why did you choose this particular saint to be your role model?



All work must be typed 12 point. Please proof-read your work and keep a copy of it. Your facilitator will read your essay so make it your best work. The bishop at Confirmation may ask you why you picked this saint and what it means to you. Your facilitator will initial it and it will go in your folder.
